

# INTRODUCING THE



*The mission of the Belgian Draft Horse Alliance is to supervise and enhance consistent, coordinated, and fiscally sound programs that contribute to the development of the Belgian Horse.*

## Trustee Structure:

- There shall be four Belgian Draft Horse Alliance Trustees.
- Two shall be Directors of the Belgian Draft Horse Corporation of America and two shall be Directors of the Belgian Draft Horse Youth and Education Fund, Inc.
- Terms will be four years in length.
- Trustees will be by respective Presidential appointment.
- Trustee vacancies will be filled by respective Presidential appointment for the remainder of the vacating Trustee's term.

## Trustee Responsibilities:

- Assure that individual programs are consistent with Belgian development
- Oversee the fiscal soundness of individual development programs
- Be a liaison with their respective Board of Directors
- Administrate the Belgian Draft Horse Alliance Funds
- Insure the deposit and disbursement of individual program funds
- Be accountable to each program for their restricted funds
- Officers-The officers of the Alliance shall be a Chair, Vice-Chair, and Secretary/Treasurer, who shall be elected by the Trustees, and such officers shall hold office for a period of one (1) year and/or until their successors are elected. Such officers shall be elected from the Trustees except the Secretary/Treasurer, who need not be a Trustee.

## Program Guidelines:

- Each program will have a specific purpose.
- Each program will be operated independently.
- All funds for the operation of each program will be held in the Belgian Draft Horse Youth and Education Fund, Inc. financial accounts (making each donation, sponsorship, etc. tax deductible) with expenses paid from these accounts.
- Internal records will be kept separately for each program.
- All programs will submit a proposed budget to the Trustees that includes all proposed income and expenses. The program will operate independently within its budget. Changes in the budget will be submitted to the Trustees.
- Programs can be temporary or continuous.
- External requests for funding will be submitted to the Trustees.
- All programs will provide the Trustees with a written annual financial report which will be published and entered on the Belgian Draft Horse Corporation of America website.
