



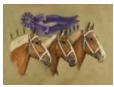
Become an ALLY in 2008!

Breeder Showcase Program

A historically significant program that recognizes the breeders of grand champions at the largest Belgian show. An original artwork is created of the champions for the cover of the Belgian Review with the breeders of the champions being profiled within the issue. Contributions to this program help cover the cost of the artwork and publication space.



Belgian Merit Program®

The Belgian Merit Program is designed to award halter points that determine national champions annually. Breeder and owner awards are presented with additional coverage in the breed publication and website. Contributions to this program help to cover the cost of awards, publication space, website updates, and future program expansion.



Registered Gelding Halter Sponsorship

Sponsorship of registered gelding halter recognizes the importance of the gelding's role in the Belgian breed. Contributions to this program help cover premiums.



Trophies and Awards

Trophies for Grand Champions are provided annually in support of many shows. Contributions to this program help cover award costs.



NABC

For two decades the NABC has rotated between U.S. and Canadian soil. The NABC has created a high profile venue for Belgian breeders, owners, and youth to showcase their animals and demonstrate the versatility of the Belgian horse. Contributions to this program help cover premiums, awards, printing costs, publication space, website space and updates, advertising, and facility costs.



All-American Contest

The All-American is an annual program in which exhibitors with qualifying animals may submit the animal's photo and qualifying year winnings as part of an overall judging contest. Contributions to this program help cover awards, publication space, and ballot printing.



Historical and Educational Material and Guidelines

The "Great Foundations" calendar series has provided a means to feature outstanding animals that had a major impact on the Belgian breed. Rarely seen photos are compiled for a lesson in Belgian history all year long. Educational materials, such as youth guidelines, help give our youth a step in the right direction. Contributions to this program help cover website space and printing.



Take The Lead Workshop®

The Take The Lead Workshop provides hands-on experience for youth and adults in a casual atmosphere perfect for learning. Contributions to this program help provide youth scholarships.



Mentor Program

The Mentor Program encourages adults to bring youth into their Belgian program whether it's showing, farming, or hobby activities. Adults can introduce a young person to Belgians who may have otherwise missed the opportunity. Contributions to this program help provide scholarships.



Youth Awards

Participation awards are provided annually to many shows. The Champion Youth Exhibitor program presents an overall award to youth competing in showmanship,

decorating, youth cart, and youth team. The Youth All-American program annually highlights outstanding youth showmen. Contributions to these programs help cover publication and award costs.
