

Belgian Draft Horse Youth and Education Fund, Inc.

All-American Showmanship Program

The All-American Youth Showmanship Award is designed to encourage and recognize the development of excellence in showmanship skills.

1. Qualifying Process

- a. Youth must have participated in four or more showmanship classes which:
 1. Have **six or more participants**.
 2. Use Belgian Draft Horse Youth and Education Fund, Inc. Youth Showmanship Guidelines.
- b. A youth selects their placing from the best four shows of which:
 1. At least one must be an All-American show as defined in the current Belgian Review.
 2. Showmanship class may be an all Belgian breed or mixed breed.
- c. Points are calculated by actual placing that occurs in an all Belgian breed Youth Showmanship Class or a mixed breed class.

Points are earned as follows:

First Place	8
Second	6
Third	4
Fourth	3
Fifth	2
Sixth	1

- d. Youth must show a Belgian horse, ownership not required.

2. All-American Qualification

- a. To be on the All-American team a youth would have to earn 26 or more points at four shows. To be on the Reserve All-American team a youth would have to earn 24 or 25 points. A youth would have to earn 23 or 22 points to be recognized for an Honorable Mention.
- b. Youth 10 through 18 years of age can participate. A calendar year (January 1 - December 31) will be used for qualifying purposes.

3. Qualification Forms
